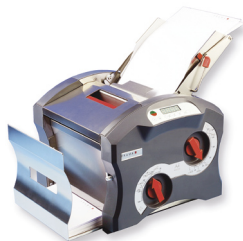

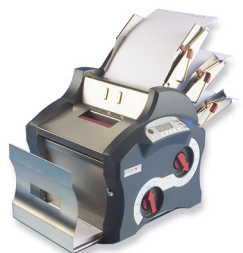

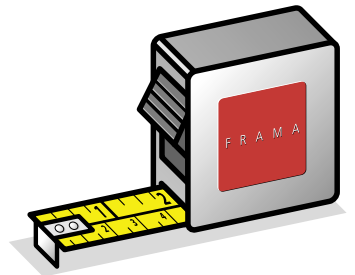
Why fold? Because postage is 26% less!

Royal Mail's 'Pricing in Proportion' means that the measurements of your letter will make the difference between paying one tariff or another.

If you send an A4 letter out in an A4 envelope, you are sending what is classified as a 'LARGE LETTER' and this makes the price you pay on postage higher. If you fold that A4 letter in half and send this out as an A5 letter (as long as the weight doesn't exceed 100g) you are now able to send the same letter in the 'SMALL LETTER' category and for this you will pay 26% less!

Save time with a folding machine because it's accurate, quicker and cheaper than manual folding.

Whether you are sending out a small, medium or large communication the likelihood is that you will not want to waste valuable resources getting letters precisely folded, especially if there is more than a single sheet to fold. It is quite an art to getting a neat fold if done manually and why do this manually when you can get the job done at speeds of up to 7000 letters per hour!
