

Shredders, what to look for...

Shredders come in lots of different guises. Things to consider are:-

- Security levels (level 6 the highest).
- Energy efficiency.
- Straight or Cross Cut.
- Volume of shredding required.
- Type of shredding - just paper or paper and media?
- Maintenance - how to keep the cutting knives efficient.

Straight or cross cut?

Straight Cut

- Higher number of sheets shredded in one pass.
- Higher speed.
- No lubrication of cutting knives.
- Shredded paper can be recycled as packaging material.

Cross Cut

- Higher security level.
- Reduction of bulk of shredded paper increases capacity of holders.

Security Levels choosing the right one for you.

Choosing the security level of your shredder will be dependent upon the activities of your organisation and the sensitivity of the data being handled. Levels 5 and 6 security are the highest and these are used by Government agencies to ensure the shredded components can never be read post shred.
