Collection of personal data when using this website

If you browse the website without login, registration or transmission of other personal information via the website, we only collect the personal data which your browser transmits to us. These are:

- Date and time of your inquiry
- Time zone difference to Greenwich mean time (GMT)
- Content of the request (concrete page)
- Access status/http-statuscode
- Data volume transmitted
- Website from which the request comes
- Browser
- Operating system and its user interface
- Language and version of browser software

This information is used wherever possible in pseudonymous / anonymous form for the purpose of analysis to improve our website and our offers. We do not use this data for profiling or advertising.

Collection of personal data when registering for the newsletter

When registering for the newsletter, we collect further personal data in addition to the data mentioned under "collection of personal data when using this website". these are:

- Gender
- Last name
- First name
- Email address
- Product area of interest
- Position in the company
- IP address
- Moment of registration / login

We use this data only to send you the desired newsletter. For further details on the newsletter, please refer to "newsletter".

Data recipients

We fundamentally do not disclose your data, with the only exception of the web analysis service google analytics by google Inc. ("Google"). See the relevant section for this.

Contact and request form

If you use our contact form for contacting our company, the personal data will be collected only to the extent of the information you have provided us with for processing your request.

Newsletter

You can subscribe to our newsletter on our website. To subscribe to our newsletter, we use the so-called "double opt-in" process. This means that after entering your email address on our website, you are sent a confirm e-mail in which we ask you to confirm your subscription to the newsletter by clicking a corresponding link. If you do not confirm your subscription within 24 hours, your registration will be automatically deleted. If you confirm the wish to receive the newsletter, we store your e-mail address until you unsubscribe. The storage is solely for the purpose of sending you the newsletter. In addition, when you subscribe and confirm your subscription, we save your IP addresses and the time so as to prevent any abuse of your personal data.

The e-mail address is the only obligatory entry for sending the newsletters. Disclosing additional data (such as your name) is voluntary and is used solely to personalize the newsletter. This data is also deleted completely upon revocation or when you unsubscribe from the newsletter.

You may revoke your consent for the reception of our newsletters at any time. This can be done by clicking on the link provided in any of the newsletter e-mails or via the contact details given below.

Cookies

For providing you with the best online experience and for enabling the use of various functions, "cookies" are used on this website. Cookies are small text files which are downloaded to your device. At the end of the browser session, most of the cookies are deleted from your hard drive ("session cookies"). Persistent cookies remain on your computer and allow to recognize you on your next visit. If you do not want this, you have the possibility to prevent the storing of cookies on your computer by means of appropriate browser settings. If you disable cookies, then the scope of functionality of our website could be restricted.

Google analytics

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses "cookies".
